



## Fulbright Interfaith Community Action Program Application Guidelines

The following items must be included in your application for the Fulbright Interfaith Community Action Program:

- **Completed and signed Application Cover Sheet**
- **A Statement of Purpose (two-three pages)**
- **A Curriculum Vitae (no longer than six-eight pages in length)**

Applicants need to complete the Fulbright Interfaith Community Action Application Cover Sheet and submit it with the Statement of Purpose and the Curriculum Vitae to the Public Affairs Office at your U.S. embassy or consulate or the Fulbright Commission in your country.

### **Statement of Purpose**

The Statement of Purpose should be no longer than three pages in length and should include:

- Your reasons for applying to the Fulbright Interfaith Community Action program
- Why your qualifications and experience are a good match for the program profile
- Concrete examples of your commitment to and involvement with promoting the ideals of interfaith community action and interreligious dialogue, tolerance, and cooperation
- What you could contribute to a U.S. host institution's programs that is related to interfaith cooperation, religious pluralism, and the promotion of interreligious understanding
- Lecture and discussion topics you would like to present as a guest lecturer at U.S. academic institutions and community organizations
- What you could contribute to the activities or objectives of interreligious community groups in the U.S.
- What kind of courses you would like to attend that would enhance your leadership and community action skills
- What types of topics and activities pertaining to interfaith cooperation and understanding are relevant to your personal and professional interests and goals
- What you expect to gain from the experience and how you would utilize what you learn at home

### **Curriculum Vitae**

Your C.V. should be no more than six-eight pages in length and should clearly reflect your involvement with and commitment to the objectives of interreligious cooperation and dialogue, i.e. through teaching, writing, research, and/or community engagement.

### **Deadline**

Please forward your complete application package to the appropriate contact at your U.S. embassy, consulate, or Fulbright commission according to the deadline they have provided you.
